The Bea Kelly Volunteer Award is unique to Soroptimist International of the Tri Cities. Its purpose is to simultaneously recognize amazing young women who volunteer in our community and also to help offset some of the costs of a post-secondary education for our award winners with a \$1500 bursary to be paid to the recipient's educational institute.

Deadline:

Completed applications and any supporting materials must be received by the above date, at the address listed in Step 3. Soroptimists and their immediate families are ineligible, as are previous Violet Richardson and Bea Kelly Award winners. Winners must have applied to, or are attending a Canadian post secondary school.

Step 1: Determine if you are eligible

Eligible applicants are young women who:

- are currently in grade 12
- are planning to attend an accredited post-secondary institution after graduation
- have had significant and noteworthy accomplishments as volunteers
- live or attend school in the Tri-Cities area of British Columbia Canada: Coquitlam, Port Coquitlam, Port Moody, Anmore or Belcarra

Step 2: Complete the application

To fill out the form:

- Click the cursor in the field you want to type in. This is a writable form which means you can type into it and save what you type.
- Before typing very much be sure it will be saved. After typing your name, select "Save As" from the "File" menu and change the file name (for example, "BKemailappLG.pdf," where "LG" are your initials). Click "Save." **Open the file with the new name to be sure your responses have been saved. If not you need to install a newer version of Adobe Reader.**
- Once all your information has been filled in, save again.
